During English lessons this term children will explore the following texts in detail :-



In the Autumn term, children will write correctly punctuated sentences, using a wide range of vocabulary and different sentence types which links to the year 3/4 National Curriculum. They will write character description and instructions.

Children will experience a wide variety of text types and develop their skills of comprehension, during our daily whole class reading sessions.

## Wider Curriculum

Through the wider curriculum we will introduce children to a wide range of subjects, enriching their knowledge of the world in which they live. Subjects will be taught through a combination of formal teaching and continuous provision where children will be able to enhance their knowledge independently by accessing carefully chosen resources and challenges. These subjects include:-

Geography - We will look at mountains around the world and how there are stone age links within some of the mountain ranges.

Science - We will focus on Rocks, Soils and Fossils.

Art - We will focus on cave art and then create our own.

Music - This term have Mr. Harrison in every week to teach the children how to play the drum.

Computing - Internet safety and how to use the internet's features effectively.

PSHE - Families and relationships.

MFL - Meetings & Greetings.

D&T - Design, Make and Improve Structures.

## Maths
