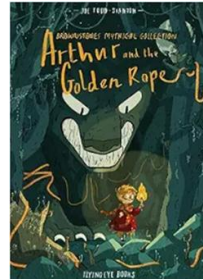
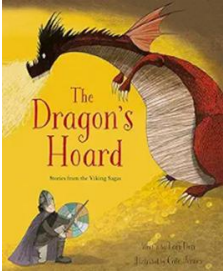


## English

- Statistics

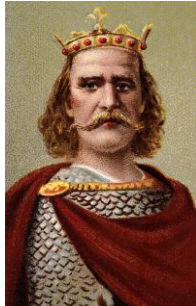
Support children at home by involving them in everyday maths tasks like shopping and cooking, Talk about days of the week, months of the year and times of day you complete certain activities.
