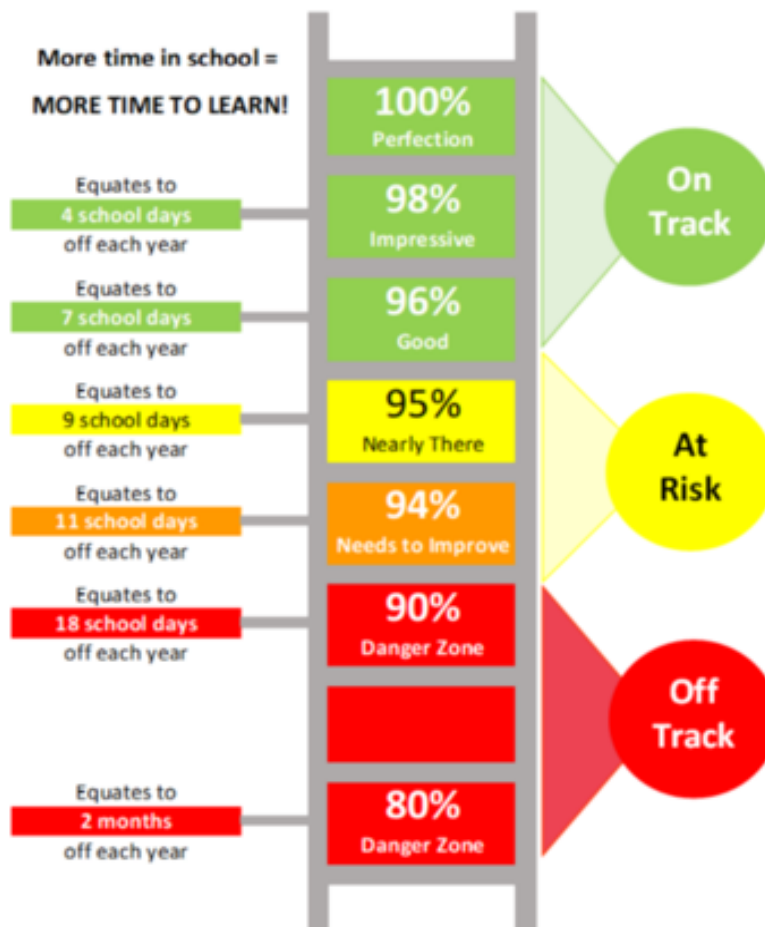
## Our Learning
